The Roaring 20s

A Look Back, A Blaze Ahead

A century ago, the 1920s were marked by prohibition, speakeasies, and a cultural shift that reshaped America's identity. Fast forward 100 years, and here we are in a new kind of "Roaring 20s," one where cannabis has emerged from the shadows, blazing trails of progress across Michigan, the Upper Peninsula, and the nation.

Cannabis has moved from whispered conversations to front-page headlines, from clandestine sharing to community-centered retail, and from stigma to acceptance. As we reflect on the first half of this decade, one thing is clear: the fire is only getting started.

A Half-Decade of Cannabis Progress

The past five years have brought sweeping change across the cannabis landscape. For consumers, this period has meant more access, better quality, and an

explosion of innovation. Let's take a closer look at what defined the cannabis industry in the early 2020s:

Legalization Takes Root

In Michigan, cannabis went from a fledgling recreational market to one of the most robust in the nation. By 2025, cannabis sales consistently rivaled—and in some months surpassed—alcohol sales. Across the U.S., more than half the states now allow for recreational use, and the push for federal reform has never been stronger.

Product Innovation Blooms

The range of available cannabis products has expanded far beyond flower and pre-rolls. Consumers now enjoy infused beverages, fast-acting edibles, precision-dosed capsules, solventless concentrates, and more. For the everyday customer, this innovation has meant more ways to fit cannabis into their

lifestyle, whether winding down at the end of a long workday, seeking natural alternatives for wellness, or simply adding some sparkle to a weekend gathering.

Normalization & Community Acceptance

Once taboo, cannabis is now welcomed into mainstream conversations. From city council meetings to kitchen tables, from medical research labs to community festivals, cannabis is being embraced as part of everyday life. This cultural shift has meant more education, fewer barriers, and a stronger sense of community around safe, responsible use.

Looking Ahead: The Next Half of the Decade

Challenges at the State Level

Of course, not every change ahead is a step forward. In October 2025, the Michigan Legislature passed a new 24% wholesale tax on cannabis, an unprecedented move that threatens to roll back much of the progress consumers and businesses have worked so hard to achieve.

For retailers, this tax increases the cost of doing business, putting pressure on already thin margins. For consumers, it risks higher prices at the register, fewer product options, and slower industry growth. And for the industry as a whole, it creates barriers that could push some people back toward the unregulated market, undermining years of work to build a safe, accessible, and community-driven cannabis culture.

This new challenge is a reminder that our work is far from over: We must continue to advocate for fair policies that keep cannabis affordable, equitable, and thriving in Michigan.

Federal Reform Will Accelerate

The momentum toward nationwide legalization is undeniable. By 2030, we may see cannabis rescheduled or even descheduled, opening the door to interstate commerce and banking reform.

Cannabis Tourism Will Thrive

Just as breweries and wineries have become destinations, cannabis lounges, events, and tourism experiences will become major draws, especially in Michigan's scenic Upper Peninsula.

Personalized Cannabis

With advances in research and technology, expect to see more tailored product recommendations based on cannabinoids, terpenes, and even genetic factors to help customers find exactly what works for them.

Everyday Normalization

By the end of the decade, cannabis use may be as unremarkable as ordering a craft beer at dinner. The stigma will continue to erode, making space for cannabis to be part of wellness, culture, and creativity.

Before our modern-day roaring '20s began, The Fire Station co-owners purchased their first storefront property in 2018: an 854 square foot condemned property that had been for sale for years on US 41 in Negaunee Township.

Hay in the walls, railroad tie trusses, and lack of running water were just a few of the challenges TFS overcame to open the U.P.'s first recreational cannabis retail store.

Flash forward to 2019-2020, and TFS kickstarted the new decade with opening its second, third and fourth locations in Marquette, Hannahville and Houghton. Houghton (pictured above) was the first brand-new construction store, with each location receiving a signature bold mural in their reception areas.



'25

TFS's much anticipated Menominee storefront opened in early 2025. The retailer also announced its plans to expand to Niles Township in Lower Michigan, which will be its 11th location.

Medical Marijuana Card Holder Benefits at The Fire Station

Are you wondering if you should get a medical marijuana card in Michigan? Here are some of the exclusive savings and perks The Fire Station's medical customers receive when shopping at TFS Negaunee.

Tax Savings

Skip the 10% cannabis excise tax and avoid increased product costs associated with Michigan's new 24% wholesale tax when you purchase medical products.

Purchase Discounts

TFS's medical customers (21+) save 15% when purchasing recreational products at any TFS adult use retail store.

Lower Age Restriction

Qualify for a med card at any age. Medical customers 18+ can shop at any medical retail store without a caregiver. Those under 18 must have a registered caregiver.

How to Get Your Medical Marijuana Card

Check Your Condition

Qualifying conditions may include insomnia, anxiety, epilepsy, arthritis, cancer, OCD and more. Check to see if your condition qualifies on the Michigan CRA website.

Get a Written Certification

Consult your primary care physician or schedule an online appointment with a registered MMJ doctor through providers like Leafwell.com or NuggMD.com.*

Apply Online

Complete your application with the State of Michigan online at michigan.gov/CRAonline.

Pay the Fees

\$40 • State registration fee
\$20-\$99 • Medical consultation**

Get Approved

The state will review your application and get back to you within 15 days.

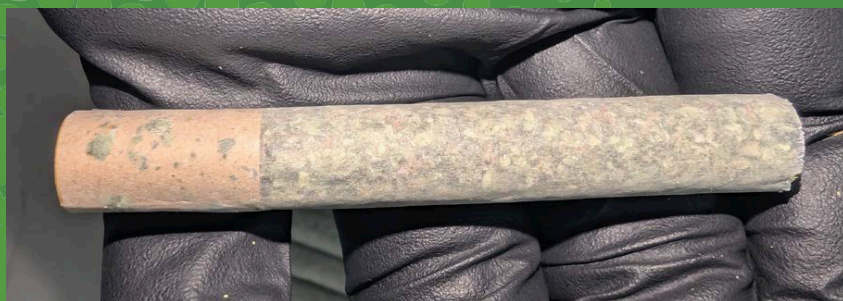

Cannabis Mocktail



Ingredients

- 1 oz Ritual Zero Proof Non-Alcoholic Gin
- 1 oz WSO Simple Syrup (infused)
- 0.75 oz fresh lemon juice
- Ice
- Lemon peel or dehydrated lemon wheel (for garnish)

Serving Size

- 1 drink
- Approx. 10mg THC

Instructions

Chill your glass: Place a coupe or martini glass in the freezer for a few minutes to chill

Mix: In a cocktail shaker, add:

- 1 oz Ritual Zero Proof Gin
- 1 oz WSO Simple Syrup (see QR code below for recipe)
- 0.75 oz fresh lemon juice
- A handful of ice cubes

Shake: Shake vigorously for 10-15 seconds until the mixture is well chilled

Strain and Serve: Strain into your chilled coupe or martini glass

Garnish: Express a lemon peel over the top (squeeze to release the oils) and drop it in, or just use a lemon wheel for garnish

Tips

- For a lighter option, top with a splash of sparkling water
- If you prefer less sweetness, reduce the simple syrup slightly and add a dash more lemon juice
- Always label as infused and serve responsibly

VAPE RECYCLING

*The Fire Station Sponsors Michigan's First
Cannabis Vape Recycling Initiative in
Marquette County*





Founded by local residents passionate about protecting the lakeshore, CSCLS advocates for Lake Superior's shoreline and watershed in Michigan's Upper Peninsula.

The Fire Station Cannabis Co. (TFS) has entered an exclusive partnership with Citizens for a Safe and Clean Lake Superior (CSCLS), a local environmental advocacy group, becoming the first cannabis retailer in Michigan to sponsor vape recycling efforts. The partnership aims to address the growing environmental problem of disposable vaping devices by creating a dedicated and accessible solution for Marquette County residents.

Disposable vapes, which contain hazardous materials like lithium batteries and concentrated liquid cannabis, pose a significant risk to landfills and waterways if not disposed of properly. CSCLS launched a successful pilot program in December 2024, collecting over 4,000 used nicotine vapes from a single drop-off point at a corner store in downtown Marquette. The success of this initiative demonstrated a clear need and community desire for proper recycling options.

The new partnership will allow CSCLS to expand its program to include cannabis vapes, offsetting the cost of recycling through TFS's financial sponsorship. The collected vapes will be sent to a nonprofit recycling center based in Michigan.

"This is a crucial step forward for environmental stewardship in the cannabis industry," TFS Chief Marketing Officer Kelsey Potes said. "By partnering with CSCLS, we are not only supporting a local organization with a proven track record, but also providing a tangible solution to a growing problem. We're so grateful to be able to provide this opportunity to the community we serve."

This partnership will give Marquette County cannabis consumers—whether they shop at The Fire Station or another retailer—convenient and compliant sites to dispose of their used vapes responsibly. As part of the program's expansion, CSCLS plans to place six new collection buckets throughout Marquette County, including Marquette Township, Negaunee, Ishpeming, Harvey, and Gwinn.

"We are incredibly grateful for The Fire Station's partnership, which allows us to expand our program and further reduce the amount of hazardous waste entering our environment," CSCLS Director Jane Fitkin said. "Everyone benefits when we work together for common-sense solutions like vape recycling."

This collaboration marks one of the first cannabis retailers in Michigan to sponsor such a program, setting a precedent for environmental responsibility within the state's cannabis industry.
