WHAT'S NEW IN THE CANNABIS INDUSTRY

Since recreational cannabis was legalized in Michigan in 2018, each year has brought new changes to the budding industry. In 2025, decisions made on the federal and state levels set in motion significant changes to the recreational marijuana market.

RESCHEDULING TO SCHEDULE III

For decades, cannabis has been classified as a Schedule I drug under the Controlled Substances Act (CSA) alongside substances like heroin. In 2022, the Biden Administration requested that the Attorney General and the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) begin the process to review how marijuana is scheduled under federal law. In 2023, HHS recommended to the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) that marijuana be controlled under Schedule III.

Data from the HHS Office of the Assistant Secretary of Health showed that across 43 jurisdictions, 30,000 healthcare providers are authorized to recommend medical marijuana to over 6 million patients for various qualifying conditions. However, as a Schedule I drug, marijuana is classified as having no accepted medical use and a high potential for abuse.

Based on the Assistant Secretary of Health's findings, President Trump signed an Executive Order directing the Attorney General to expedite the move of marijuana to Schedule III on Dec. 18, 2025. It's important to note that cannabis has not yet been downgraded to a Schedule III drug.

The president's executive order calls marijuana's current Schedule I status an oversight and says it "has limited the ability of scientists and manufacturers to complete the necessary research on safety and efficacy to inform doctors and patients."

Additionally, cannabis companies can't deduct standard business expenses, like rent or payroll, due to federal tax laws under Schedule I. Moving to Schedule III effectively ends this penalty, potentially saving Michigan businesses millions in federal taxes.

Rescheduling does not mean federal legalization, and marijuana would remain a controlled substance, but with less restrictive oversight.





2026 HEMP BAN

New federal rules set to take effect in November 2026 will redefine "hemp" to effectively ban many intoxicating hemp-derived products that currently exploit legal loopholes.

In late 2025, new federal legislation effectively outlawed most hemp-derived THC products, such as delta-8, delta-10, and THCA, by reclassifying them as controlled substances with a compliance deadline in late 2026. This move dismantles a massive grey market, creating a significant ripple effect across Michigan.

While public health advocates view the ban as a necessary win for consumer safety, the industry is bracing for a major shake-up. Michigan's licensed adult-use retailers can expect a surge in demand as consumers transition from now-outlawed products to regulated cannabis, placing a premium on brands that offer transparency and rigorous lab testing. While this shift benefits established, compliant operators and premium brands, it forces small hemp-focused retailers to either pivot their business models or exit the market entirely.

MICHIGAN'S WHOLESALE TAX

After years of declining prices, Michigan has some of the cheapest weed in the country. While costs have risen due to the new wholesale tax, The Fire Station is taking a thoughtful approach to offsetting these. This includes working closely with our suppliers to secure the best pricing possible and evaluating efficiencies across our operations. Our goal is to protect affordability and accessibility while continuing to provide the quality and service our customers expect.

The 24% wholesale tax applies to marijuana sales from growers and processors to retailers. Customers have not experienced an increase in taxes on their purchases. Michigan shoppers are still responsible for the existing 10% excise tax on retail marijuana sales, along with Michigan's 6% sales tax. The wholesale tax applies only to recreational marijuana products. Medical marijuana is exempt.

The tax is projected to raise approximately \$420 million a year, which will be dedicated to funding Governor Whitmer's \$1.8 billion road plan.

Many people involved in Michigan's cannabis industry strongly oppose the new tax. The Michigan Cannabis Industry Association, the state's leading cannabis trade group, filed a lawsuit shortly after the budget passed, seeking to block the tax. A Michigan judge denied the state's request to dismiss the lawsuit in January, but the 24% tax remains in effect while the lawsuit continues.

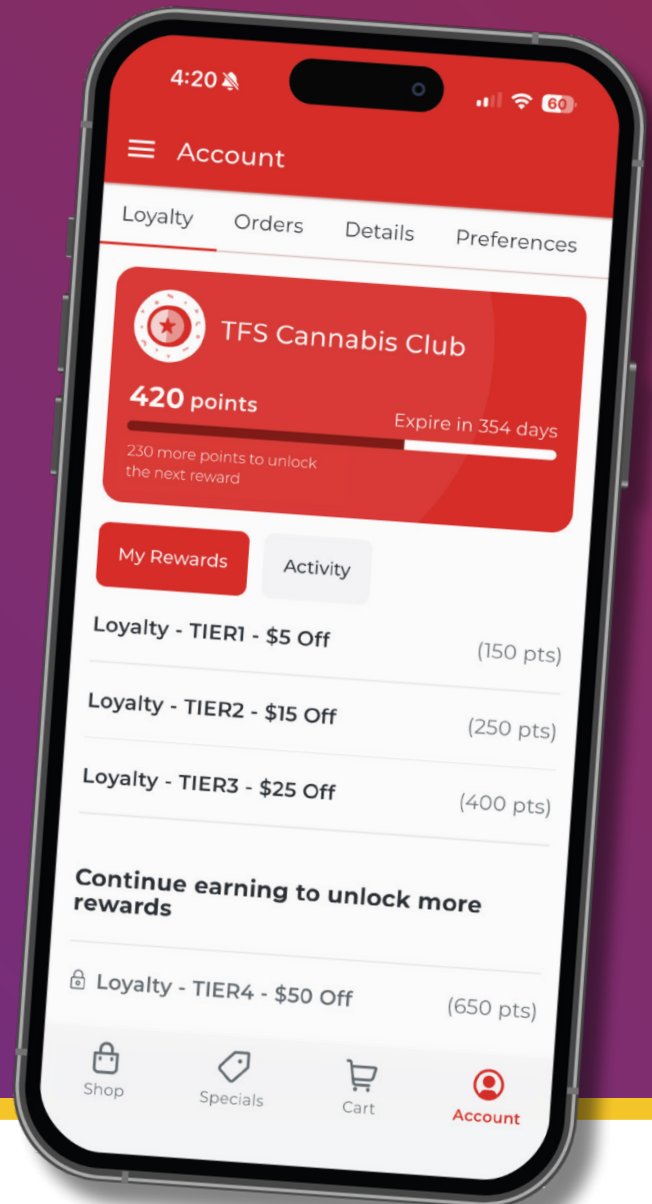

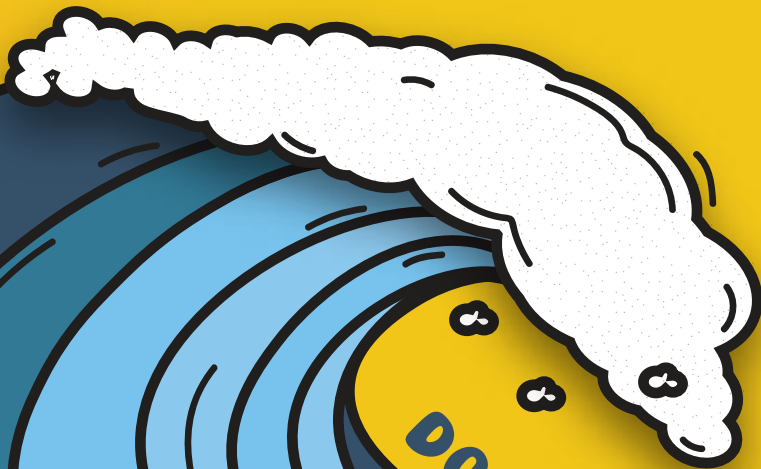

COOKING WITH CANNABIS

NADA PIÑA COLADA

Transport yourself to the tropics with a fresh and creamy non-alcoholic, cannabis-infused Piña Colada. Swap the rum for your favorite cannabis tincture for a custom buzz. This mocktail is a vacation in a glass, no flight required!

INGREDIENTS:

- Makes 16 oz. (serves 1-2)
- 1 cup frozen pineapple chunks*
- ½ cup pineapple juice
- ½ cup cream of coconut*
- Cannabis tincture of choice*
- Pineapple wedge and maraschino cherry for garnish

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Chill the glasses the drink will be served in and prepare garnishes.
2. Add frozen pineapple chunks (or ¾ cup fresh pineapple and ½ cup ice), pineapple juice, and cream of coconut to a blender.
3. Add the amount of cannabis tincture you want to enjoy to the mix.
4. Blend on high until all ingredients are completely smooth.
5. Garnish with a pineapple wedge and a maraschino cherry.

NOTES:

To substitute fresh pineapple, use ¾ cup fresh pineapple and ½ cup ice. Cream of coconut and coconut cream are not the same! This recipe calls for cream of coconut, a sweetened syrup used for drinks and desserts. Use your preferred dose of cannabis tincture

DOSING NOTES:

The strength of your drink depends on the potency of the tincture used. Always calculate total THC per serving based on your infusion and how much you used in the recipe. Also, remember that it takes longer to feel the effects of edibles. If unsure, start with a smaller dose and see how it affects you before enjoying more.
